Youth After School Programs



Youth After School Programs (Youth Force)

The City of West Park Youth Force Afterschool Program provides activities addressing the developmental and social-emotional needs of middle school-aged students residing or attending a school in Broward County; in order to reduce risk factors related to teen pregnancy, delinquency, substance abuse, family dysfunction, mental and physical health challenges, negative peer associations and school failure. The program provides year-round services designed to improve self-esteem, develop skills and increase access to community resources in order to promote both current and future successes. Services Include-general assessment, case management, informal counseling services, goal development plan, support services, academic support, healthy snacks & meals, field trips, community service projects, teen outreach instruction, nutrition and fitness activities, cultural arts, enrichment activities, and career exploration opportunities. This free program is funded by the Children Services Council (CSC) of Broward and is administered in collaboration with Memorial Health Care System at Mc Tyre Park Monday through Friday, from 2:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. during the school year and from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM during the summer. Camp B.R.A.V.E.R.Y. After School & Summer Program

This program is funded by the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ). The goal of these prevention services is to divert youths who pose no real threat to public safety away from the juvenile justice system through activities that support a safe environment and provide youth and their families with positive alternatives for delinquent behaviors. The program provides afterschool and out-of-school activities addressing the developmental and social-emotional needs of children 5 to 17 years old, residing or attending a school in Broward County and/or surrounding communities. Services include academic support, healthy snacks & meals, field trips, community service projects, nutrition and fitness activities, cultural arts, enrichment activities, and career exploration opportunities. The program is free and is administered at Mary Saunders Park Monday through Friday, from 2:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. during the school year and 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM during the summer. BSO Law Enforcement Programs

- The Law Enforcement Explorers Program at the Broward Sheriff's Office is a successful example of how adult intervention can instill responsibility, leadership, teamwork, and self-reliance. The program works with teens and young adults (14-20 years of age) by allowing them to interact with law enforcement and other community advisors in a serious, regimented atmosphere where the students can demonstrate their personal initiative. The program offers young adults the opportunity to learn and experience lawful citizenship as they participate side-by-side with law enforcement deputies and civilian personnel in ongoing training and community service projects.
- Explorers receive a wide variety of training, including basic and advanced Law Enforcement Explorer Academy training programs, including, but not limited to self-defense, patrol procedures, traffic stops, report writing, domestic violence, Florida law, and arrest procedures. Explorers who first enter the program are placed on a six-month probationary period. All explorers are required to attend weekly meetings, which include wearing their uniforms for inspection and training seminars.
