West Park Families Matter Outreach Initiative

As an update, we launched the City's West Park Families Matter Initiatives through our vendor and partner, Memorial Healthcare Systems. This program is funded from the City's American Rescue Plan Act Funds. The program provides comprehensive services to residents (youth & families) exhibiting multiple risk factors including; substance misuse, family conflict/stress, behavioral issues, financial issues, unemployment/underemployment, and family management problems to name a few. The goal of the program is to service 125 adults and/or families with children that reside within the City of West Park limits.

- **Household Hazardous Waste and Electronics Program:** In accordance with the City agreement with Broward County, residents can drop-off household hazardous waste and electronic waste at the transfer station located at 5601 W. Hallandale Beach Boulevard. This free drop-off service is allowed, The resident's free drop-off is allowed on Saturday's from 9AM to 3PM.

As reference, the City's services agreement is available for review.

- **Bulk Trash & Yard Waste Drop-off Program:** In addition to the City's monthly curbside bulk trash and yard waste pickup services, residents can drop-off bulk trash and yard waste at the Broward County Trash Transfer station located at 5601 W. Hallandale Beach Boulevard, at no cost to resident. The resident's free drop-off is allowed on Saturday's from 9AM to 3PM.

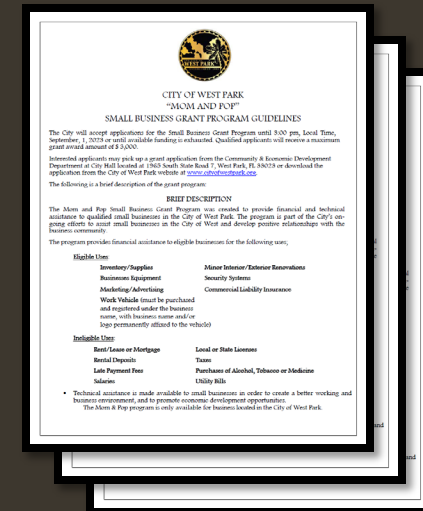

Community & Economic Development Programs

MINOR HOME REPAIR PROGRAM:

-
- The City's Minor Home Repair Program was created to assist eligible "low-income" residents in obtaining much-needed health, safety, and welfare-related home repairs;
-
- The program is designed to provide repair assistance for home electrical systems, plumbing systems, AC systems, roofing systems, doors, windows, floors, etc;
-
- Funding is available to West Park residents on a limited, first come, first serve basis. The maximum program award amount is up to \$3,000;
-
- The program is designed to facilitate homeowner occupancy; and each subsequent year the homeowner continues to reside in the property, one-third of the grant award will be forgiven; after three years of home occupancy, the total amount will be forgiven.



Community & Economic Development Programs

MOM & POP SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM:

- The City's Small Business Grant Program commonly known as the "*Mom and Pop Small Business Grant Program*", was established to provide financial and technical assistance to qualified small businesses located in the City of West Park;
- The program provides funds on a reimbursement basis for business-related expenditures including the purchase of business equipment, business supplies, advertising and marketing services liability insurance costs, etc;
- The maximum award amount through the program is \$3,000 and will be provided to the grant awardee on a reimbursement basis. Grant funding will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis;
- This year's program is scheduled to be advertised within the next 30-60 days at which time a copy of the Minor Home Repair Program's grant application will be available on the City webpage or by visiting the Community & Economic Development Department in City Hall at 1965 South State Road 7, West Park, Florida 33023.
