CITYWIDE SIDEWALK RESTORATION AND ADA COMPLIANCE - PHASE 1

1. With multiple locations will multiple contractors be awarded contracts?
Answer: The project will be awarded to one (1) contractor.
2. What is the budget for this project?
Answer: Please refer to Project Data Sheet posted with the Bid package.
3. Are there plans available for this project?
Answer: The sketch provided within the Project Manual (Attachment 1) will provide the general location(s) of areas to be addressed. Repairs will be performed in accordance with all criteria as outlined in Section 3.3 Replacement Concrete Sidewalk of Attachment 3 Scope of Services / Technical Specifications.
4. What are requirements for underlying material where sidewalk is being reconstructed?
Answer: Please refer to Section 3.3 Replacement Concrete Sidewalk of Attachment 3 Scope of Services / Technical Specifications of the Project Manual.
5. Will there be handicap ramps?
Answer: Cast-in-place detectable warning mats will be installed per ADA requirements at existing ramp locations at intersections highlighted in sketch provided in the Project Manual (Attachment 1). Existing ramps will be modified only for controlled stop (i.e. Stop sign) locations.
6. Are areas to be repaired already marked in field?
Answer: Due to the timeline between when damaged areas were first identified and when the contract is expected to be awarded, areas were not previously painted as the markings would have faded over time. Therefore, the City will conduct site visits with the awarded contractor just prior to the commencement of construction and mark all locations to be improved while staying within established quantities and budget. However, the sketch provided within the Project Manual (Attachment 1) will provide the general location(s) of areas to be addressed.

7. What is the required mix design for concrete?

Answer: Please refer to Section 3.3 Replacement Concrete Sidewalk of Attachment 3 Scope of Services / Technical Specifications of the Project Manual.
